


The **Dois Corvos** brewery, located in East Lisbon, provided big quantities of glass bottles, coming from faled bottling processes. Because of the high igienical standards to be complied, when there is a leak or other problem in the bottling line, it is more expensive to sanitise those bottles than using new ones. So, at the end of the bottling process, some bottles are unusable and, therefore, discarded.

The **ComVidro** atelier transformed the bottles provided by the brewery into handcrafted design products by means of cutting, drilling and sanding glass and other reclaimed materials such as wood, cork and natural stone.

The participants of the initiative, promoted by the association **Bairro**, were unemployed women in vulnerable

situations.





Diagram of bottle cuts and corresponding products produced:
